## 2008 SPRING SPECIALS & RECOMMENDED VACCINES FOR 2008

If you haven't vaccinated your horses yet, consider our spring special – the gold standard – includes a brief exam and dental exam, basic vaccines and dewormers, dependent on your needs. We spend enough time with you to answer your questions about your horse. We recommend EWT-WVV (encephalitis, tetanus and West Nile) and flu/rhino as our basic vaccines. As of April 2008 we are also recommending rabies as a standard vaccine.
